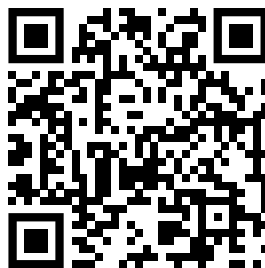

THE PROJECT

Our West Organ sadly came to the end of its working life in 2017, but we are embarking on an exciting restoration project, which will support:

- our growing Congregation;
- our Parish, through exciting performance opportunities;
- and the wider local community, through education.

We have sourced pipework from a historic 1906 Lewis & Co organ found in St Paul's United Reform Church right here in Croydon. Respected Organ builder Nicholson & Co of Malvern has been commissioned to build the new instrument.

The new organ will be made up of 1,784 individual pipes, which will range from the size of a pencil, up to 16 feet in length, and in volume from the whispering Vox Angelica to the majestic Tuba.

From as little as £20 you can adopt a specific pipe in the new organ, and choose from a specific stop and pitch.

By adopting a pipe you can become a part of this historic instrument and contribute to maintaining the UK's rich musical heritage.

HOW IT WORKS

From the project website you can select any available pipe in the new organ – exactly as you would for a theatre seat – and make your payment online.

Alternatively, make your choice from our display in church, fill in the form on this leaflet and pay cash in person at the Parish Office (Monday-Friday, 9.30am-4pm).

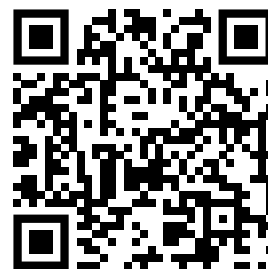
You will receive a specially-printed certificate with your name and the details of the pipe(s) you adopt.



Your name will be added to the display and will be recorded in a permanent Supporters Book to be kept in the Organ.



You will be entered into a draw for two tickets to the inaugural recital on the new organ, on Saturday 16th November 2024.

ADOPT A DRAWSTOP

Drawstops are the knobs on the organ console that the organist pulls to select a particular set of pipes. For £200 you can adopt a drawstop on the organ console that controls any of the 35 speaking stops (sets of pipes). There are also 18 other drawstops available at £100 each.

Just as with adopting a pipe, you will receive a certificate and your name and drawstop will be recorded in our permanent Supporters Book, plus the chance to see your Drawstop up close and in action!

COMPOSITION DRAW

Have your pipe featured in a specially-written new composition!

If you adopt a pipe in one of the stops listed below, you will be entered into an additional draw. One pipe from each stop will be randomly drawn, and will be featured in a new composition so you can specifically identify it!

The featured stops are:

- Bombarde 16
- Open Diapason 1 8
- Lieblich Gedact 8
- Vox Angelica 8
- Clarionet 8
